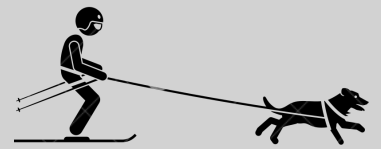

Please note that the Swedish sled dog sports association has not updated the classes in the competition calendar based on current regulations for skijoring 2 dogs (SML2, SWL2) or skijoring 2 dogs sprint (SM2, SW2), therefore we will use other designations for these classes.

If there are less than three participants per class, men and women will be combined into a mixed class (this refers to classes SM1, SW1, SM2 and SW2)

Sign-up: via draghundsport.se if you compete for a Swedish club and have a FID number. Otherwise: send an email to board@jfshk.se with your name, contact details, class(es) you wish to compete in & type of dogs. You will receive a sign-up confirmation email back.

Note: when competing for a foreign club you need to show a proof of insurance when registering at the race office.

Latest registration day P4: 15 December 2024

Latest registration day other classes: 29 December 2024

Late entry: with late entry (latest 6 January 2025) an extra fee of 150SEK is applicable.

Race rules:

The race is held under IFSS rules, plus Swedish additional rules.

Parking:

The sled teams get to park closest to the starting line and then we fill up with smaller teams further down the road (see map on the next page) The parking will be signed according to the classes, but directions from our volunteers always prevail, so follow their instructions! And please park SMART so that we have space for everyone.

Race office, opening hours & registration requirements:

Friday 17:00 - 19:00 hrs > MD teams obligated to register during this time slot as your start is early Saturday morning.
Saturday & Sunday: 07:30-11:00 > Sprint/skijoring teams (note: closed during musher meetings).

The race office is located in the same building as the restaurant (see signage on-site). Start numbers can be collected upon showing vaccination paperwork, registration certificate (those of you with Green Card competing for a Swedish club) or insurance certificate (participants competing for foreign clubs associated with IFSS) and submitting chip lists.

Additional requirements for those running Siberian Huskies and wanting to collect merit points for becoming Swedish working dog champion: a copy of foreign dogs' pedigrees & form signed by the participant (dogs should be minimum 18 months). For questions about merit points qualification, contact Camilla Engvall directly.

Trails & markings:

Trails will be marked with red and blue turning and confirmation signs with class notification on them, according to IFSS rules. At places we consider it necessary we will close off parts with crossed marker sticks and/or barrier tape. More information about the trails will be provided at the musher meetings that are mandatory to attend (no attendance at the musher meetings = no start).

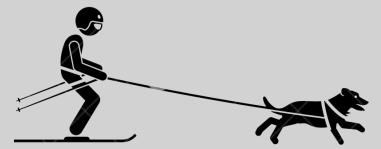
No training on race trails on Friday after 14:00hrs and on Saturday after 18:00hrs as we close the tracks for preparations for next days' races.

Stake-out rules:

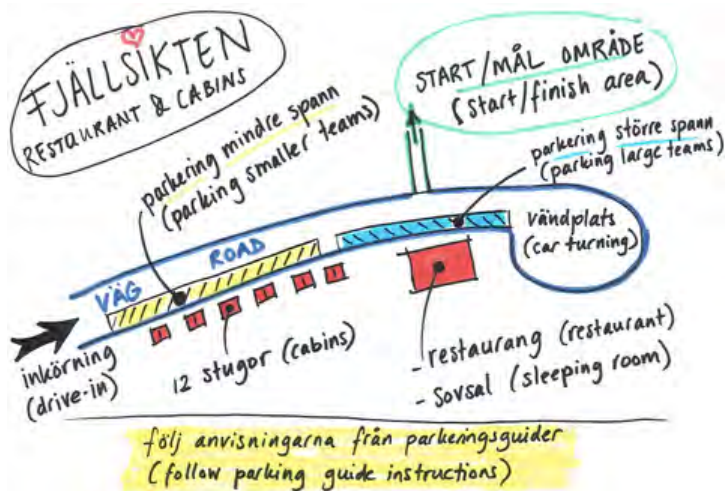
No loose dogs in the area.
